Description:

Fisher Town Design was hired to design and lead a bilingual town planning effort in Pescadero along with a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Consultant. Pescadero is an unincorporated town with a 'Mendocino' type feel. It has historic buildings on its Main Street and citizens that are passionate about its past and future. Previous planning workshops had not been successful in attracting the Spanish-speakers which make up about half of the population. Puente received a grant from the Silicon Valley Community Foundation (with the blessing of San Mateo County) to prepare and hold a workshop and focus groups to break through the barriers that Spanish speakers have to participating in public forums. The workshop was very successful with 217 people in attendance including 80 who only spoke Spanish. Future phases of this project are planned.
